Status Of The Dam/Dredge Project Bobbi Coulter

. All laws, appropriations and approvals have been finalized regarding our NJDEP loan. We have not yet received our letter informing us that we may present our documents for closing on the loan. Our contact at the NJDEP says to expect that in the next weeks.

. The Harding Township Committee has passed the resolution to cosign the loan with us. They have also provided us with a letter summarizing our responsibilities regarding the loan. Copies of that letter will be distributed to every homeowner when we receive notice to begin our loan closing.

. We sent requests for bids to 10 qualified contractors. Each of the bidding contractors has visited and inspected our site and is very aware of the details of the required work and the constraints of the work area. We requested bids for several different approaches to the work - assuming we have enough soil, assuming we don't, etc. We received 3 bids ranging from \$600,000 to \$850,000. We are working with our project engineer and the bidders to understand the cost drivers and determine if we can negotiate some of this expense out of the project, but can expect that the final cost will be within 20% ofthese bids.

. There will be much heavy traffic on Lake Trail West during the three to four months of construction. As soon as we have a schedule for beginning construction, I will be meeting w/ parents of school age children to strate-gize regarding safety precautions.

LAKE LOWERING THIS OCTOBER

On or about October 1st, we will begin dropping the Lake 4 - 6 feet. We will do this whether or not we have finalized our NJDEP loan and/or our dam/ dredging contracts. Whether or not we dredge this year, this lowering will permit homeowners to work on their docks and water line. It will also buy us an additional couple of months to finalize decisions and schedules for the dam/dredge project. That is, we are only allowed to drop the lake in October, but once it is lowered we can keep it down all winter and spring for dredging and dam work. If we can't do the project this fall, winter or spring, we'll allow the lake to fill for the summer and drop it again next fall. The lowering will be contingent only on the NJDEP approval of our application for permission to lower and it is very, very likely we will receive that.

This is NOT a decision to proceed w/ the dredging even if we haven't yet closed on the loan. It is ONLY a decision to proceed w/ the lowering. If you have any questions, please contact Bobbi Coulter on her cell phone (201-321-7722).


Roads
