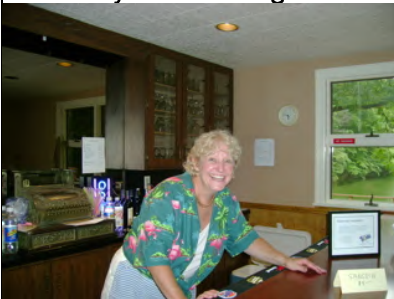
Welcome, New (and Returning) Residents!
