removed by the Monday 5/2 pickup. Just as we are advised to remove cars from our roads for snow removal, so too must we not block our roads with any debris that could prevent safe access to the community by Fire, Police, and Rescue Squad emergency vehicles!

Also, if you have material that has not been placed at roadside by the time of the pickup, you are responsible for removing it yourself.
