### Board Votes NOT to Sell Our Water System

At its March 11th meeting the Association Board reviewed the Water Committee's report and voted not to pursue a sale of our water system to the one bidder that had remained interested in purchasing our facilities. A second bidder had withdrawn from the process earlier.

This decision keeps the control of our water system in Community hands, but it does mandate that we remain vigilant in overseeing and improving our facilities into the future. One first step is the purchase of a backup generator to assure that we can keep water pumping in the event of extended power outages such as those we have experienced in the past two years.
