### Water Committee Report Recommends Sale

#### Board Votes to Recommend No Sale

The Water Committee has completed its analysis and due diligence on Aqua NJ's bid to purchase our Water System. At the March 11th Board meeting, The Committee presented its report recommending that we pursue the sale. (A second bidder had withdrawn from the process earlier.) The MKLA Board voted to recommend NOT to pursue the sale.

The Water Committee's report and the Board's recommendations will both be made available to the Community shortly and the date for the Special Meeting for Community vote on the matter will be announced concurrently.
