Rick Barrett, Water Chair, has ordered a custom-build generator for our pump house. It is due to arrive by the end of October, so our continuing water supply should never again be jeopardized by any power outages.

Also in the works is a maintenance plan for the water tanks to ensure the safe storage of the water we pump.

A Note from our Treasurer

Roads Chair Tim Lucaks has been working hard to keep our roads in good condition. The work on the Elm Trail/ Lake Trail West segment has been completed, as planned, and the hill at the Beach was also completed by taking advantage of the contractor's availability while on site.

The unexpected sinkhole at the bottom of Lake Trail East has been repaired, with some assistance from the Township. The Township be repaving Bailey's Mill Road later this year and will complete the repaving of the segment still open at that time. This unanticipated work has put us over our projected 2013 roads budget by approximately \$25,000. Treasurer Bobbi Coulter is confident that this can be handled by making modest adjustments in our overall spending plans.
