be upon us as the joy of living in this special place reveals itself again for another year. There are a few basic steps that every member of this community can take to protect our lake.

1) Have your septic cleaned every two to three years. (A maximum of five year intervals will soon be mandated by law.)

2) Control the use of toxic chemicals in your home and yard. Fertilizers can be purchased that do not contain phosphorus.

3) A barrier of shrubs, trees, etc., separating your lawn from the lake is the best filtration system for keeping toxins from running directly into the Lake.
