Water System News

Rick Barrett, Water Chair, reports that a standpipe has been installed for pumping water from the Lake near the pumphouse. This will allow the Fire Department to access water from the East Side, in addition to the two fire lanes on the West Side.

A siphon system has been installed at the dam to replace the old valves, which were no longer functioning. This will allow the lake level to be lowered in the event of an emergency.

Annual Meeting Items

At the Annual Meeting of the Association on Friday, January 23rd, the following sums were approved to be allocated from long-range planning funds for ongoing improvement projects:

\$73,000 for water tank refurbishment \$20,000 for dredging the lagoon \$50,000 for road sealing
