Our water system is up and running again after repairs were made during the last week in August to pipes on Lake Trail West. In addition, we are hoping with DEP approval to use well 3 attached to Pumphouse 2 during the upgrade to supply the community and avoid any disruptions in water service. Additional but routine testing on the new well will be necessary before the DEP will permit it to be utilized.
