An Important Notice from our Assistant Treasurer:

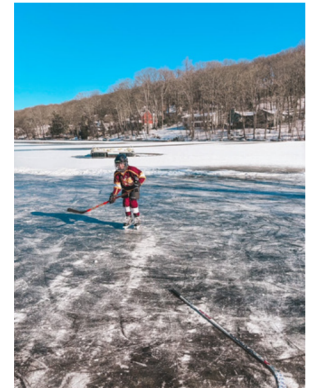
A dues increase was voted on and approved by members. Quarterly dues will now be \$900, effective April 1, 2024. Thank you.

*This photo of our Clubhouse was taken around 1940. The building was completed and opened in July 1936.
In 1986 the addition of the upstairs kitchen and bar was built, funded by voluntary subscriptions. (The original kitchen and bar were in the basement! Some current residents recall carrying food up the circular stairs for parties.)
In 1994 the deck was added (also contribution funded).
in 2019 the portico was added, funded by a donation by Father Corr, a former resident.
In 2023 the kitchen ramp was added as remediation and the inside was refurbished.
