CLUBHOUSE

BEACHES & DOCKS

Don received a rather costly estimate from Steve Collier for repairing the steps on the east side of the lake. The proposal included concrete and crushed stone at an anticipated cost of \$4,400. The Board was reluctant to proceed in this direction and suggested using the prior method of fixing the steps which was less costly. Diane agreed to help Don investigate alternatives.

Work was completed at the dock near the fire lane. Steve Collier repainted and sanded the old float for more traction. The Board asked Don to ensure there is still room for the fire trucks in this area should the need arise.

Don will work with Chris Allyn to estimate the current depth of the lagoon, and most importantly what it should be. It may be time to begin setting aside funds for dredging. He will check with Terry Dwyer for a record of previous dredging.

ROADS

Summer road patrol is proceeding. Nothing significant has been reported.

TREASURER

Insurance premiums have been paid. Bob reviewed the cash flow forecast.
