WATER SYSTEM Rick Barret - <u>ribarrett@aol.com</u> – The syphon System is almost complete. Thursday the back of the dam will be seeded. The work came in under the amount budgeted, and the entire job cost us about \$10,000 over what had been previously done.

The bi-annual DEP inspection found a few spots on the spillway, the wall and dam which we are required to have patched.

The horizontal tank is back in service. All the leaks are gone but there may have a little seepage, especially by the hatch cover. It will have to opened again when we put the pump in may need a new gasket.
