
Celebrate Guy Bowden's 90th on Alaska's Inside Passage

One of the top items on Guy's "bucket list" is sailing the Inside Passage in Alaska. For his 90th birthday, several of us are escorting him on the trip and would like to encourage any of his friends who would like to do so to join us. Here are the details:



The Cruise: We are departing from Anchorage in the afternoon of Monday, July 29 and sailing to Vancouver, BC, arriving Monday, August 5th. Along the way we will visit glacier including Glacier Bay and the towns of Skagway, Juneau and Ketchikan. There will be a variety of optional excursions.

The Ship: The Island Princess (Princess Lines) was launched in 2003 and refitted in 2010. She is mid-sized, accommodating up to 1970 passengers on 12 decks. She offers a range of amenities from multiple restaurants, theatric presentations, movies and lounges, to a spa, hot spots, hot tubs and a gym.



The Cost: The pricing is some of the best we could find. Inside cabins start at \$1,300. Oceanview/balcony cabins are just over \$2,000 and mini-suites start at \$2,300. All prices are per person based on double occupancy and include all on-board meals, taxes and fees. Optional services and side trips are extra. A deposit of 25% is required at booking. Some bonuses may be available for early booking.

Note: if we group-book 8 staterooms a discount would apply.

Getting There: United offers the only non-stop to Anchorage from Newark and only on Saturday. We deliberately picked a Monday sailing to allow for touring Anchorage and maybe more importantly to adjust to the time difference. Transfer from Anchorage to the ship will be arranged for those wanting it for \$50. There are daily United non-stop options back to Newark from Vancouver.
