

Mr. George E. Wrigley died Tuesday October 2, 2012 in Morristown, NJ. He was 92. George was born on February 27, 1920 in Bernardsville, NJ to the Late Mary nee:Weir and George E. Wrigley. He lived in Basking Ridge, Berkeley Heights and Millington, NJ before moving to Morristown, 38 years ago.
